

What is ISCC PLUS?

- ISCC PLUS is a sustainability certification program for bio-based and circular (recycled) raw materials for all markets and sectors such as the food, feed, chemical and energy markets and for technical applications.
- The ISCC PLUS has a focus on the sustainability and traceability of raw materials within the supply chain that includes circular and bio-based materials such as plastics, food ingredients, animal feed, chemicals and bioenergy.
- The ISCC PLUS scheme is becoming the globally recognized standard for the recovery of waste and residues that provide the feedstocks for circular plastics, chemical intermediates, and therefore a wide variety of consumer facing products like packaging, housewares, toys, etc.

Circular Economy: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

- Plastic is everywhere. Unfortunately, there is no globally standardized approach to handling plastic waste properly. Only 9% of all mass-produced plastics ever manufactured have been recycled by 2015 (Geyer, R. et al; 2017), due to the limitations of collection systems and mechanical recycling.
- Instead of banning plastic from modern society, the circular economy takes a more general approach to the plastic waste problem. The idea of a circular economy is based on the concept: **Reduce, Reuse, Recycle**.
- In a circular economy, no plastic ends up in the environment. Improved technologies and applications can stimulate demand for collection and recycling.
